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Clinical Indications for Admission to Home Healthcare

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- Home healthcare is/was needed for appropriate care of the patient because of **ALL** of the following[AI[B][C][D](1)(2)(3)(4)(5):
 - The patient has had a face-to-face encounter with a physician or allowed non-physician practitioner (NPP) no more than 90 days prior to (or within 30 days after) the start of care related to the home health service needs. [E](6)
 - The patient is Homebound.
 - The patient's needs can be safely met with Intermittent home care.
 - o The patient needs education on condition and self-management care with teach-back.(9)
 - Skilled care at home is required for 1 or more of the following(10):
 - Clinician assessment after emergency department or observation care without hospital admission(11)
 - Coordination of care with case management program (ie, condition management, care transition)(12)(13)
 - Home safety assessment[F](15)(16)
 - Infusion (IV) therapy management (eg, insertion site use and care, infusion administration, monitoring reaction)(17)
 - Medication management, adherence instruction, and side effects assessment(18)(19)(20)
 - Nutrition and hydration management(21)
 - Psychosocial assessment, management, and referrals(22)
 - Rehabilitation therapy or equipment coordination[G][H][I][J](27)
 - Respiratory status assessment(28)
 - Significant chronic condition exacerbation with need for clinical intervention and monitoring(29)
 - Telehealth services establishment[K][L](30)(32)
